Call of Applications for Forensic Science Internship Programme at Directorate of Forensic Science Laboratories, Karnataka

Forensic Science Internship Programme is an opportunity for the participants to get in-depth knowledge about the working pattern of the Directorate of Forensic Science Laboratories in Karnataka. It also provides them with the opportunity to learn about the process of collection and scientific analysis of physical material evidence and the administrative procedures followed in the forensic laboratory. It is also an opportunity for an intern to have hands-on training under the guidance of qualified and staff.

Eligibility:

B.Sc/M.Sc in Forensic Science, Bio-tech/ B-tech/M-tech/ Computer Science, and Computer Forensics.

How to apply:

Participants who desire to participate in the program are requested to fill in the required details in the internship application form, along with the requirements as noted below.

Requirements:

1. Internship application form. No relevant column of the application form should be left blank; otherwise, the application form will not be accepted.
2. A recommendation letter from the college, institution, or university where you last attended.
3. "Character Certificate" from College / Institution/University.
4. Attested copy of ID proof issued by the College/Institution/University last attended
5. A self-attested copy of any one of the government-issued address proofs (driver's license, Aadhar card, or voter ID).
6. Self-attested copies of proof of qualification.
7. The students who are selected for internship have to submit a police verification certificate from the local police station of their residence within 7 working days, certifying that no criminal antecedents are pending against them.
8. The students who are selected for internship have to sign a contract/undertaking with DFSL, Bengaluru, on the stamp paper of Rs. 20/- according to the terms and conditions laid down by DFSL. (Notarized undertaking)

Note:

1. Participants are limited to 25 (on a first-come, first-served basis).
2. The name of the selected applicant will be noted on the official website, and an email will be sent.
3. Preference will be given to students from recognized universities in Karnataka.
4. Interns will not be paid any scholarship or stipend during their stay with DFSL, nor will they be provided lodging, boarding facilities, or travel allowances.
5. The intern shall be completely responsible for bearing his/her complete expenses during the internship period.
6. The selection in the internship programme is neither a job nor any such assurance for a job by DFSL, Bengaluru. Interns will not be deemed working professionals at DFSL. Interns should not represent DFSL in any official capacity.
7. Director, FSL may terminate the internship program at any time without giving any reasons and with immediate effect if the organization is of the view that the internship is detrimental to FSL.
8. Director, FSL reserves the right to depute the intern to any of the 7 RFSLs viz. Ballari, Belgavi, Davangere, Hubli, Kalaburagi, Mangaluru, Mysuru or SFSLBengaluru during the period of internship.
8. Attendance as per norms is mandatory for the intern to get the certificate from the DFSL.
9. Depending upon the number of applications received, Director, FSL reserves the right to decrease the number of seats and the right to frame selection procedures. No claim shall be entertained regarding the selection or rejection of the applications for internship in any regard.
